

Setting up PayPal Express:

You will want to open two tabs or browser windows on your computer. In one login to your PayPal account and in the other login to your ShopSite store.

In PayPal, you may need to convert the account type to a business account if it isn't already. In the top right corner you should see a green circle with a profile in it next to your name. If you hover over it with your mouse you will have the option to click on Account Settings.

The Braintree SDK is powered by Braintree, a PayPal service. These easy to integrate SDKs allow you to accept payments via PayPal on your website and native mobile apps.

You or your developer integrated NVP/SOAP (or "Classic") APIs that allow you to accept payments via PayPal.

For preconfigured shopping carts: Copy and paste the API username, password, and signature into your shopping cart configuration or administration screen.

For building custom shopping carts: Store the following credential information in a secure location with limited access.
